IT MAY BE THAT NO PRIEST IS READILY AVAILABLE, BUT YOU AS A FELLOW CHRISTIAN SHOULD NOT BE AFRAID TO GIVE THE SICK PERSON THIS HOPE AND REASSURANCE. YOU MAY WISH TO USE SOME OF THE PRAYERS AND SHORT READINGS GIVEN BELOW
