Excursions Last week I asked you whether you might be interested in a visit to the Cathedral in the Autumn. No response. I also asked whether you thought it was good idea to have an Auction of Promises & Items for Charity, as a thanksgiving for the new windows. No response. But someone has mentioned that they would like there to be a Pilgrimage to Walsingham. Is there any interest in that? I'm only too ready to arrange a Pilgrimage if people would like to go. Please tell me.

THE NAVE WINDOWS

The installation of the new Nave Windows is due to begin tomorrow, and will continue each day this week. Because of this, Mass on Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday will be at 8.0am, so that the glaziers can get going at 8.30am each day. On Friday, being an important feast, the Mass will be at the usual 11.30am time, but whether Exposition & Rosary will be able to follow on as usual is not clear at present. I hope so.

First Holy Communion In the next (very) few weeks it will be time to begin preparation for First

Holy Communion in Summer 2024. Children should be starting Year Three at School now to be eligible. Please will Parents wishing their children to be prepared make contact with Fr.John as a first step.

BUT It has happened not infrequently in the past few years that children have appeared, who, with their parents, are quite unknown to us, and seem to have had no prior involvement with the Church - at least since Baptism. We have duly prepared them, and then they have disappeared once more almost immediately after having made their First Holy Communion. This is less than satisfactory. And so we are no longer happy about accepting children for First Holy Communion preparation just 'out of the blue'. We intend asking that Children who, with their parents, have not had anything previously to do with the life of the Church should attend Children's Liturgy and Mass on Sunday mornings - regularly - for a year before we think about First Holy Communion preparation. It is depressing as regards Baptism that we so often seem to be producing instantly lapsed Catholics. We do not want to produce instantly lapsed Catholic communicants as well!.
