Posada - an Advent devotion

Pray for Bethlehem... This will be the second Christmas where Manger Square and the Church of the Nativity in Bethlehem stands virtually empty for the Christmas season because it is not safe for pilgrims to visit. Pray for the people of the Holy Land over this season as they struggle with war and with dwindling numbers of pilgrims. They are struggling financially with a lack of employment and a very uncertain future. Many, in Gaza particularly, have lost everything. Cardinal Pizzaballa, the Latin Patriarch of Jerusalem visited the UK recently and spoke about the hope that still remains amongst the Christian community and that our prayers and support are vital.

Stella Maris - Many thanks to all who helped to make the soup lunch for seafarers such a success - those who made cakes, donated tombola prizes, produced soup and desserts and helped on the day. Most of all thanks to all the generous people who came on the day or sent a donation. The total raised was £601.56.
