As we complete 9 Days of Mourning - offering our prayers for the eternal repose of Pope Francis, the Universal Church now invokes a particular out-pouring of the Holy Spirit upon the College of Cardinals. The Cardinals have already been meeting in 'Congregation', including those who are over 80 years of age, to reflect and discuss prayerfully in preparation for the Conclave. The Cardinal Electors, those under 80 years of age, will enter Conclave on 7th May. I call upon every member of this Local Church, the Diocese of East Anglia, to join me over the coming days in offering fervent prayer in support of the Cardinal Electors. We entrust the Church to Divine Providence as we await the election of the 267th Successor of St Peter. I urge each Parish to celebrate a Votive Mass to the Holy Spirit.

Good Shepherd Sunday – 11th May

Sunday 11th May is Good Shepherd Sunday; a day when we reflect on how the ministry of Christ as Priest, Prophet and Shepherd continues in the Church through the ordained priesthood. Priests do not fall from Heaven ready-made. The call to priesthood needs to be heard, vocations need to be nurtured, and funding is needed to provide for priestly formation. The cost of training a priest is more than £150,000. We all have our part to play in praying, encouraging vocations and financially supporting the formation of our future parish priests.
