As some of you may know two of our parishioners - Dennis and Wilf – help to run a *Martial Arts Group* which meets every Thursday evening in St Felix Church Hall at 7pm. Both are proficient self-defence instructors and along with another colleague, Peter, would like to offer <u>FREE one-off sessions</u> in self-defence for any member of the Parish that may be interested.
